BORDER #1:

You will cut 4 - 2" Strips for the inner border. After sewing, using a 1/4" seam, you will have a 1 1/2" Border. You can either use a jelly roll or cut strips of your own. It is up to you. After all, this is your quilt. I recommend using at least 1/4 of a yard for your inner border.

BORDER #2:

You will cut 4 - 5 1/2" Strips for the outer border. After sewing, using a 1/4" seam you will have a 5" Border. I recommend using at least 1 yard to 1 1/2 yards for your outer border. I always like to have a little extra fabric on hand just in case I make a mistake or don't calculate correctly. It just depends on what your preference is.

FINAL QUILT MEASUREMENTS SHOULD BE: 42 1/2" X 45 1/2" (PLEASE NOTE: THAT THIS IS THE SIZE IT WILL BE BEFORE QUILTING AND BINDING. QUILTS HAVE A TENDENCY TO SHRINK A BIT DURING THE QUILTING PROCESS. JUST KEEP THAT IN MIND IN CASE YOUR QUILT DOES SHRINK A BIT. IT'S NOT A HUGE AMOUNT, BUT IT CAN BE AS MUCH AS 5 INCHES DEPENDING ON YOUR DESIGN AND DENSITY.
